1. Introduction

Today, many countries of the world, including India, are facing acute water crisis. Realizing the same problem, Hon'ble Prime Minister has called for the construction of 75 Amrit Sarovars (ponds) in each district of the country. Amrit Sarovars will play an important role in increasing the availability of water, both on surface and under-ground. Development of Amrit Sarovars is also an apt symbol of constructive actions, dedicated to the country on the occasion of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, marking 75 years of Independence from colonial rule, that create sustainable and long term productive assets, beneficial to both the sentient beings and environment.

Objective of Mission Amrit Sarovar is "construction/development of at least 75 Amrit Sarovar (ponds) in every district of the country". Each Amrit Sarovar will have pondage area of minimum of 1 acre (0.4 hectare) with water holding capacity of about 10,000 cubic meter.

Mission Amrit Sarovar was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister on the eve of National Panchayat Day on 24th April 2022. This exercise began henceforth so as to complete a substantial number of structures by August 15, 2022. Those States, who find it difficult to adhere to the above timeline on account of early rains or other such factors, e.g. the states in the North-East, are allowed to seek permission for following a different timeline within the financial year 2022-2023. In any case, all such Amrit Sarovars should be completed by end of Amrit Varsh i.e. 15thAugust 2023.

2. Brief District Profile

Khawzawl district is one of the eleven districts of Mizoram state in India. Khawzawl district was recently created on 3 June 2019. The district is spread over four Legislative Assembly constituencies; Champhai North, Hrangturzo, Lengteng and Tuichang. There are twenty eight inhabited towns and villages in this district. Khawzawl town itself has around 3,000 family residing in it. It is estimated that there are around 14,000 people residing in Khawzawl town. Khawzawl district has around 7,372 families with 36,381 people residing in it. The main towns and villages in Khawzawl district are: Aizawl, Arro, Biate, Chalrang, Chawngtlai, Chhawrtui, Dulte, Hmuncheng, Kawlkulh, Khawhai, Khualen, Lungtan, Ngaizawl, Neihdawn, N.Chalrang, Pamchung, Puilo, Rabung, Riangtlei, Sialhawk, Tlangmawi, Tlangpui, Tualpui, Tualte, Vankal, Vangtlang, Kawlkulh N, Vanchengpui and Khawzawl town itself.

Khawzawl district has a moderate *climate*. In winter the temperature varies from 0 °C to 20 °C and in summer, the temperature varies between 15 °C and 30 °C. In terms of *transport*, the Distance between Khawzawl and Aizawl is 152 km. Khawzawl is connected with regular service of Bus, sumo (Passenger vehicle) and helicopter.

Geographically, the district is bounded on the north and west by Saitual district and on the south by Serchhip district, on the east by Champhai district. Khawzawl district is the only district in Mizoram that has no international boundaries and inter-state boundaries. Khawzawl town is the administrative headquarters of the district.

4. District Level Committee

For the effective implementation & coordination of Mission, a **District Level Committees on Amrit Sarovar (DLCAS)** will be formed under the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Khawzawl District with all the stakeholders involved. The committee will ensure vertical and horizontal coordination and monitor progress of the Mission from time to time. The composition of the District Level Committee for Amrit Sarovar(DLCAS) is as under:

Chairman : Deputy Commissioner, Khawzawl

Member-Secretary : Project Director, DRDA, Khawzawl

Members : Executive Engineer, PHED

Divisional Forest officer, Wildlife Division Block Development Officer, Khawzawl

District Local Administration officer, Champhai District Fisheries Development officer, Khawzawl President, Village Council Association, Khawzawl

The main functions of the DLCAS will be:

- a) Engagement and meeting together with participating departments.
- b) Approval of Amrit Sarovar Sites proposed by participating departments.
- c) Fixation of timeline for completion of Amrit Sarovar sites.
- d) Effective monitoring of implementation of Amrit Sarovar Sites.

5. Participating Department

Amrit Sarovar guidelines has laid down that Ministries/Departments and Organizations would work together to accomplish the goals with the following Ministries and Organizations

- 1. Ministry of Rural Development
- 2. Ministry of Jal Shakti (Dept. of Water Resources/ Dept. of Drinking Water & Sanitation)
- 3. Ministry of Culture
- 4. Ministry of Panchayati Raj
- 5. Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change
- 6. Bhaskaracharya National Institute for Space Applications and Geo-informatics (BISAG-N)

However, the meeting of the District Level Committee has decided to engage Department of Rural Development and its Block level office under Block Development Officer alone due to the advantages as follows:

- Existing MGNREGS under which a large amount of Pond construction had already been included in the Annual Action Plan by Village Employment Councils.
- Existing Monitoring tools and apps such as Area Officer App, GeoMgnrega and NMMS already utilised by MGNREGS
- Existing VLAA under MGNREGS who could function as Panchayat Level officer

^{**}Foundation stone for the Amrit Sarovar will be led by freedom fighter or her/his family member or by the family of martyr (post-independence) or a local padma awardee. In case there is no such citizen available, the eldest citizen of the specific/local gram Panchayat to be engaged.

^{**}On the occasion of every Independence Day (i.e. on 15th August)Tricolor to be hoisted at Amrit Sarovar worksite, by the freedom fighter or his/her family member or by the family member of martyr or a local Padma Awardee.

7. Official Functionaries at Village Level

Amrit Sarovar guidelines mandated the selection of two dedicated Prabharis for each Amrit Sarovar i.e. Panchayat Pratinidhi and Panchayat level officer. Gram Panchayat will nominate Panchayat Pratinidhi, who will act as citizen supervisor and responsible for faithful and fair execution of the Amrit Sarovar in the Panchayat while protecting the community interest. Considering the administrative set-up of the state, it is advisable that all Gram Panchayat may, but not strictly, select its Village Council Secretary to be the Panchayat Pratinidhi. This is expected to simplify a lot of things as the Village Council Secretary is usually the person who go to towns and cities regularly to do official dealings and he/she is normally updated with modern technical know-how which will make it easier to coordinate with the village level functionaries.

Under MGNREGS, every village has a *Village Level Administrative Assistant(VLAA)* who does the work of geo-tagging, measurement of works etc. at village or panchayat levels. Each VLAA will act as a *Panchayat level officer* who will monitor the progress and ensure faithful implementation of the mission in panchayat while reporting the progress in the form of document, with appropriate photos and videos.

8. Role of Deputy Commissioner in Monitoring

- Finalization of Amrit Sarovar site.
- Implementation of the Mission and ensure its timebound completion.
- Arranging preparation of Detailed Project report (DPR).
- Earmarking sources of funding of arranging approval.
- Ensure coordination among participating counterpart District level line departments.
- Identify a Panchayat level Officer for each
 Amrit Sarovar Site
- Carry out a monthly review of the progress of the Mission and apprise the State Nodal Officer

- Work upon the feedback provided including those by the Central Nodal Officer
- Apprise Central Nodal Officer of the progress and issues, if any, concerning the Mission.
- Documentation of achievements and outcome of Mission.
- Monitor progress of Mission through Mission
 & program portals. She/he will also be responsible for arranging regular updation of data/response to the feedbacks.
- Be responsible for the resolution of grievances and troubleshooting. xiii. IEC and environment creation

9. Monitoring of progress of Amrit Sarovar Sites

Amrit Sarovar will be utilising various supervision tools which is already being utilised for monitoring under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS.

- National Mobile Monitoring System (NMMS): Real-time attendance at worksite Will be taken twice a
 day through National Mobile Monitoring System.
- Area Officer App: Area officer app will be utilised by Deputy Commissioner, Project Director DRDA, BDO for inspection and monitoring of the gram Panchayat along with Amrit Sarovar worksite.
- A monitoring committee to monitor the construction of works under Amrit Sarovar will be formed by the DLCAS comprising of the following:

Chairman : Assistant Engineer, DRDA

Member-Secretary : Additional Programme Officer, Khawzawl RD Block

Member : Junior Engineer, PHED

Technical Assistants under O/o DRDA & BDO, Khawzawl.

10. Documentation

The guidelines on Amrit Sarovar has mandated that each state and district should separately document the entire initiative by properly recording various stages of development of Amrit Sarovar, unique features of mobilization of the community, for further submission to the central ministry.

The responsibility of *documentation* of Amrit Sarovar initiatives shall fall upon the Block Development Officer, Khawzawl RD Block. He shall also be responsible for administering the Amrit Sarovar app such as :

- Marking Area of Amrit Sarovat in the app.
- Updating of Physical Progress
- Filing up of panchayat level functionaries.
